The Lighthouse Club was established in Hong Kong in 1986 and now has a membership of over 800, with a wide cross-section of people associated with the construction industry being represented. Ordinary membership is open to all individuals connected with the industry, Associate membership is available to non-industry persons and Corporate membership is open to all corporate bodies connected with the construction industry. Separate memberships for young members (under 35) and student members are also available.

On the corporate front, the Lighthouse Club has provides an opportunity for a company to be recognised as a proactive supporter of safety in the industry and the provision of assistance to those directly affected by accidents. The Lighthouse Club also provides companies with an ideal networking opportunity through participation or attendance at the various functions, seminars and forums held throughout the year. Corporate membership entitles companies to nominate up to five Nominee Members to the club.

The Lighthouse Club has a well-supported social calendar with events and functions taking place throughout the year. These include the Annual Dinner, Annual Ball, Safety Awards, Site Visits and so on. Every month the ever-popular "get-together" takes place at the Delaney's in Wanchai. The Lighthouse Club Golf Society is very active, with regular outings arranged in Hong Kong and throughout the region. Young members are also well-catered for, with an active Young Members Section organising many regular social and professional events.

In recent years, the Lighthouse Club has organised a number of successful seminars covering a broad range of topics of current interest to those associated with the construction industry.

The Lighthouse Club Charities benefit from the proceeds of all events and functions organised by the Lighthouse Club.

The Lighthouse Club has branches worldwide - in the Asia Pacific Region there are branches in Bangkok, Kuala Lumpur, Macau, Manila, Pattaya, Phuket, Singapore, Vietnam in addition to Hong Kong. Lighthouse Clubs in the Asia Pacific Region provide reciprocal membership benefits to each other members and the Asia Pacific Region produces a full colour Magazine showing the activities of the Clubs in the region, three times a year.
